About This Safari:

Experience a glorious week of thrilling guided safaris from two camps in the Southern Section of the world-renowned Kruger National Park. No less than eight exciting day drives in an open safari vehicle, one thrilling night safari make up this incredible adventure safari package.

Africa's 'Big 5' - Elephant, Lion, Rhino, Buffalos and Leopard - they're all here. Daily at sunrise you set out hoping to spot them all – and a host of other fascinating animals of the wild. By driving to different areas of the park you witness different Flora and fauna. Zebra, many species of antelope and Wildebeest are dotted over the open plains as the predators lurk in the undergrowth.

A fish Eagle with its distinctive cry soars above. He's just one of a myriad of over 500 species of birdlife found here and your knowledgeable safari guide relays fascinating facts and interesting anecdotes. On your night safari you thrill to the sounds and smells of the night and your spotlight picks up Africa's 'creatures of the night' – scavenging wild dogs and Hyenas, Naagapies (Bush babies) and the prized sighting of a Leopard on the prowl.

All-inclusive are: comfortable chalet accommodations with en-suite facilities and air conditioning; all transport including collection and drop off to Johannesburg, Pretoria or Oliver Tambo airport - and open safari vehicles in the park; breakfasts and dinners, registered professional safari guides; eight day and one night safaris, and entrance and conservation fees.

Day to Day Summary:

Day 1: Johannesburg – Kruger Park

From the Kruger Gate we start our game drive slowly making our way to the camp for lunch (own account) game viewing on the way. After lunch we continue our game drive until gate closing. Dinner is in the restaurant.

Day 2: Kruger Park

Early morning departure from camp as the gates open and we start our game drive hoping to spot the elusive Leopard on the prowl or a group of Lions resting in the road. We stop off at a camp for breakfast and then depart once again on your drive returning at mid-day to rest before departure again late afternoon on another drive till gate closing.

Dinner will be served in the restaurant at 19h00pm.

Day 3: Kruger Park

Another early morning, we depart this camp with our luggage as we move to another camp for the next two nights we start before sunrise allowing you time to take some stunning pictures of the Sun rising over the African landscape as we make our way out hoping to still find our cats on the prowl or enjoying a hearty meal after their nights kill. Breakfast can be enjoyed at one of the camps before we make our way to another Southern camp with check in by 14h00pm. This evening you may enjoy a night drive conducted by National Parks rangers returning to camp late evening.

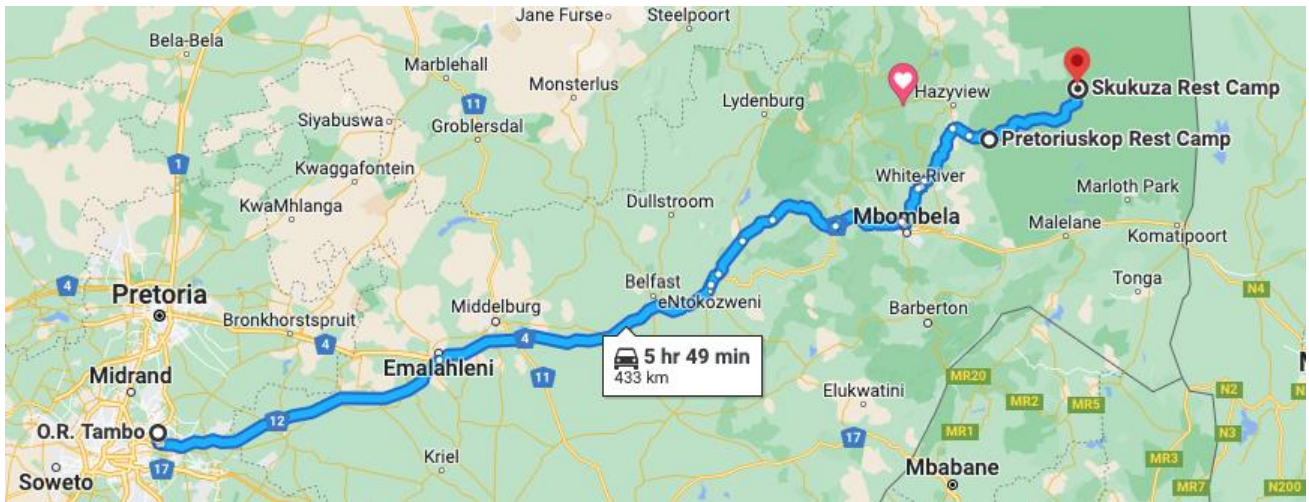
Day 4: Kruger Park

This morning we embark on another early morning game drive before breakfast exploring a different section of the park with great anticipation of coming across great sightings. We return mid-day allowing you time to enjoy a swim or a siesta before we depart from camp three hours before gate closing for an afternoon game drive, stopping off at waterholes hoping to come across our Rhino taking a mud bath or a herd of elephants enjoying a swim, or buffalo wallowing along the edges of the waterhole. We return to camp for a shower and dinner. After dinner your guide will discuss the next day's activities as we head on back to the game enriched Southern section of the Kruger National Park.

Day 5: Kruger Park - Johannesburg

We depart early from camp as soon as the gates open for a game drive returning for breakfast after which it is time to pack up and exit the park by 11h30am to arrive back in Johannesburg by 17h00pm / 18h00pm

Accommodation:

This Safari includes accommodation within the Kruger National Park. The huts are cleaned and serviced daily and feature twin beds, bathroom en-suite and air-conditioning.



Meals:

Dinners & Breakfasts are included in the package. Lunches are for your own account as well as premium/specialty drinks. Restaurant Facilities are available in every Camp within te Kruger National Park.



Game Drives:

All daily Game Drives are included in the package and are conducted in open aired safari vehicles accompanied by an expert guide. The Open Safari vehicles have blankets and ponchos/ rain coats onboard for any weather changes.



Sunset/Night Drives are conducted by Kruger National Park Rangers. A Sunset Drive leaves at 16:30pm and returns to camp at 19:00pm and the Night Drive leaves at 20:00pm and returns to camp at 22:00pm. Both are subject to availability.



Children:

Children are welcome on this safari however due to safety and comfort, any children under 8 years of age, you will need to organize a private safari tour for your group, with no other guests onboard. Children under 12 years pay 50% of the adult rate. Children 12 years and above pay the full adult rate. Children under 13 years are not permitted on bush walks due to safety.
